

CLIMAAX Barcelona Workshop

Venue

The CLIMAAX Barcelona Workshop will be held at the [CosmoCaixa – Science Museum](#), located at [Carrer d'Isaac Newton, 26](#).

All participants must enter through CosmoCaixa's main entrance and find the Workshop **registration desk**, where you will receive your **personal badge**, and a **ticket to the museum** (required to access the Auditorium).



Keep in mind that the museum' ticket is necessary to access and is only valid for the day. Then, **registration will take place on both days** of the workshop:

Tuesday, 10 June
13:45 - 14:15

Wednesday, 11 June
08:30 - 09:00

At the end of the event, participants are welcome to stay and visit the museum, using the same ticket.

How to get to CosmoCaixa?
